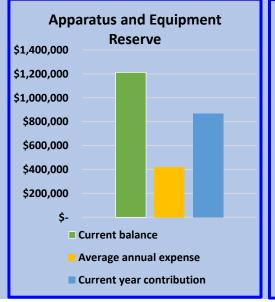


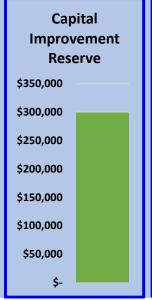

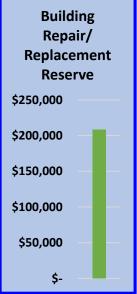

WHEREAS, pursuant to MCA 7-33-2105, the Hyalite Rural Fire District Board of Trustees have the authority to provide adequate and standard firefighting and emergency response apparatus, equipment, personnel, housing, and facilities, including real property, for the protection of the fire district; and

WHEREAS, MCA 7-33-2105 requires the Board of Trustees to prepare annual budgets and request special levies for the budgets of Fire Districts; and

WHEREAS, on August 13, 2021, the Hyalite Rural Fire District posted and published notice of the meeting and a copy of the agenda in which the budget for Fiscal Year 2022 was to be considered, and

WHEREAS, on August 17, 2021 a meeting of the Board of Trustees of Hyalite Rural Fire District was held to consider the Estimated Fiscal Year 2022 budget, and

WHEREAS, a quorum of the Board was present; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees allowed the public to comment on the Estimated Fiscal Year 2022 budget in the form of written comment and oral testimony; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees seeks to receive the same amount of tax money in Fiscal Year 2022 as in Fiscal Year 2021, plus the money on newly taxable property, inclusive of the inflationary adjustment authorized by state law, and the Fiscal Year 2022 revenue should be over and above all cash carryovers from Fiscal Year 2021; and

WHEREAS, in determining whether to levy the full maximum mills, the Board of Trustees considered that there has been no significant decrease in calls for service during the last fiscal year, fire calls and mutual aid calls have increased and therefore an additional appreciation in the total number of calls is anticipated in Fiscal Year 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees also considered the number of critical apparatus, equipment and structures owned by the District are in need of repair or replacement; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has determined that the maximum number of mills allowed by state law is necessary to adequately fund the ongoing public health, safety and welfare duties and activities of the District in order to meet their statutory obligations; and

WHEREAS, the Hyalite Fire District has assumed the debt from the Sourdough Fire District bond in the amount of two million, nine hundred thousand dollars (\$2,900,000) requiring the payment of principal and interest in Fiscal Year 2022.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED:

- 1. The Estimated Fiscal Year 2022 budget has been established and is hereby presented as described in Exhibit "A".
- 2. The Board of Trustees request the Gallatin County Commission levy the maximum number of mills allowed by current state statute, based on updated certified taxable values from the State of Montana, Department of Revenue.
- 3. The Gallatin County Commissioners include the cost of debt service of \$222,028 as an additional tax as authorized by the voters.
- 4. A copy of this Resolution and attached exhibits shall be forwarded to the Gallatin County Finance Director.
- 5. If needed, the Finance Director is authorized to balance our preliminary budget calculations by either increasing or reducing our future year Capital reserve to meet expected revenue.

August 2021

- 1. The Hyalite Fire Department has responded to 391 calls in 2021 (as of 8/01/2021).
 - o We were at 317 calls in August 1st 2020
 - We were at 297 calls in August 1st 2019
 - We were at 271 calls in August 1st 2018
- 2. Our current roster is at 44 members (effective 8/01/2021).
- 3. We currently have 8 resident firefighters living at the Sourdough Fire Station.
- 4. We currently have 4 resident firefighters living at the Cottonwood Fire Station.
- 5. We still have 3 resident renters at the Rae house.
- 6. We continue our regular training every Wednesday night and command training twice a month.
- 7. The open burning closure remains in effect for the Hyalite Fire District. Gallatin County also remains under a full fire ban signed by the county commission.
- 8. Assistant Fire Chief Chris Dahlhauser has started as of July 26th. Chris is getting up to speed with our operations. Training Captain Malcolm Malone will start on August 18th.
- 9. Fire Chief Nickolay deployed for six days with the DNRC County Assist Incident Management Team to the Grass Slough Fire outside of Colstrip, MT in mid-July.
- 10. We are still waiting on a report from Poindexter Audio on the sound test from the Sourdough Fire Station conference room.
- 11. The solar panel project has been completed at the Sourdough Fire Station. The system is monitored and working properly.
- 12. Hyalite Rescue 6 and a crew of firefighter participated in the Sweet Pea parade in Bozeman on August 7th.
- 13. We have experienced no firefighter injuries or significant mechanical breakdowns in the last month.

Conceptual Renderings for a Fire Station

The Hyalite Rural Fire District (District) anticipates that future growth in our district will increase demand for fire and emergency services. As part of our regular capital facilities, equipment general planning process, we are interested in engaging the services of a qualified architectural firm to provide District Trustees and residents with conceptual renderings of a new fire station located on District property at 5400 Gooch Hill Road, Bozeman, Montana.

The desired end result is that Trustees and residents are much better informed as to:

- (1) The design and features of a new station.
- (2) The general range of total project cost, and
- (3) Various options for construction, e.g., a phased approach separating residential quarters from equipment bays.

The nature of the work to be accomplished is best described as the vender driving an informed conversation with trustees and residents, setting the stage for more traditional work sometime in the future, e.g., final site plan development, structural design, architectural detailing and construction bid document preparation. This work would ultimately be used to provide district residents information ahead of a vote to approve final project financing though a bond. However, at this time the Trustees seek only to be better informed about our options.

Fire Chief's Report

September 2021

- 1. The Hyalite Fire Department has responded to 433 calls in 2021 (as of 9/01/2021).
 - We were at 365 calls in September 1st 2020
 - We were at 351 calls in September 1st 2019
 - We were at 335 calls in September 1st 2018
- 2. Our current roster is at 45 members (effective 9/15/2021).
- 3. We currently have 8 resident firefighters living at the Sourdough Fire Station.
 - o Sourdough resident firefighters continue to fill weekend shifts Friday 7pm Monday 7am
- 4. We currently have 4 resident firefighters living at the Cottonwood Fire Station.
 - Cottonwood resident firefighters continue to fill week day nights shifts Monday Thursday 7pm
 7am.
- 5. We still have 3 resident renters at the Rae house.
- 6. On Monday September 20th we will be implementing our non-resident day staffing plan. Non-resident firefighters will be covering six hour shifts at the Sourdough Fire Station on Monday Friday. This will brings our total staffing to twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week utilizing resident and non-resident firefighters.
- 7. We continue our regular training every Wednesday night and command training twice a month.
- 8. Open burning closure remains in effect for the Hyalite Fire District.
- 9. We responded with auto aid partners to a mobile home structure fire on September 9th. The fire was located on Buffalo Orchard Trail within the Covered Wagon Trailer Court. An occupant was trapped within the structure. First arriving law enforcement from the Bozeman Police Department were able to rescue the individual. The occupant and four law enforcement officers from Bozeman PD were sent to the emergency room for evaluation and care. All were released the same day without significant injuries.
- 10. Training Captain Malcolm Malone started with the Hyalite Fire District on August 18th.
- 11. We participated at the Montana State University Catapalooza recruitment event on August 23rd. We have had an incredible interest in the Hyalite Fire Department. Interest has showed people are finding out about the Hyalite Fire Department at Catapalooza and on our website.
- 12. We had 20 people show up for our new member informational meeting on September 8^{th} . We will be interviewing candidates September $16^{th} 18^{th}$. After interviews we will select our eight new volunteer firefighters. The fall firefighter academy will start on September 22^{nd} .
- 13. The solar panels at the Sourdough Fire Station have showed a savings in electrical cost. The system is monitored and working properly. We are waiting to hear from Sunny Portal if there will ever be charges associated with monitoring of the system.

- 14. Hyalite Fire has been participating in discussions with Gallatin County Emergency Management and the Gallatin County commission on a county ambulance service contract. This contract would provide contractual coverage of ambulance service to areas in Gallatin County who do not provide their own service. Currently there is no ambulance service contract for Gallatin County. The contract will still allow Hyalite Fire to provide our own BLS ambulance service. The contract is currently set to be signed by the county commissioners.
- 15. We have experienced no firefighter injuries or significant mechanical breakdowns in the last month.

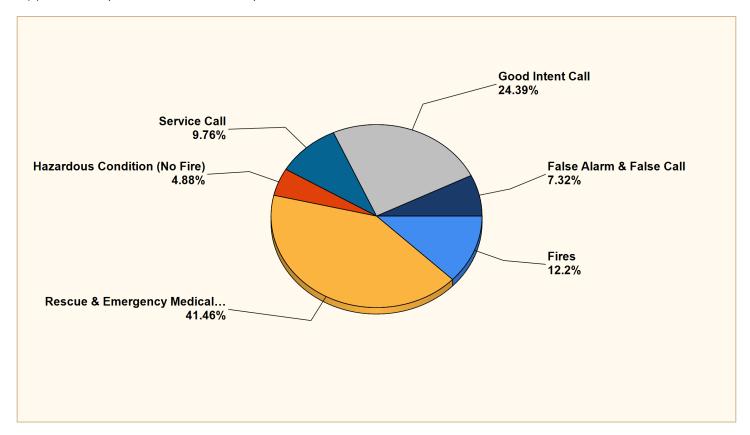

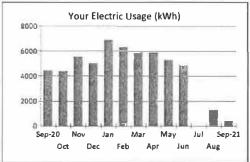

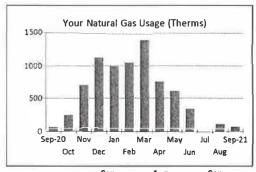
